She hobbled around on 3 legs, unable to use her left front leg, and her 2 front paws were scraped and badly infected. A trip to the vet also revealed an old injury-a broken hind leg. After months of antibiotics and treatments her front paws are healed, though she still doesn't use her left paw. Her hind leg doesn't appear to cause pain or mobility issues. The life of a feral cat is not easy. Emmy would not fare well outdoors so she is now a Snowflake Angel and will live safely indoors.
